Terms & Conditions for events organised by the Society of Maritime Industries

1. Subject to the prior agreement of the speakers, summaries of the presentations made will be available to delegates who attend, only after the event, and only on request to the Events Manager by e-mail (events@maritimeindustries.org). These summaries will be distributed by email or on CD ROM if distribution by email is not technically feasible.
2. Receipt by the Society of Maritime Industries of a properly completed booking form signed by a delegate is contractually binding irrespective of whether payment has been received. Where payment is not made by credit card at the time of receipt of the booking form by the Society of Maritime Industries, it must be made within 7 days of receipt of an invoice from the Society of Maritime Industries.
3. Changes of delegate names can be made up to 3 full working days before the event but fees cannot be refunded for cancellations received after the registration deadline. Refund for bookings cancelled before expiry of the registration deadline will be limited to 50% of the fee.
