INTRODUCTION

Cammell-Laird Shipbuilders is preparing to bid to be prime contractor for the Type 31e Frigate Programme in partnership with BAE Systems and will be holding a Supplier's Conference in Birkenhead for Tier 1 and Tier 2 sub-contractors and the wider supply chain.

The conference will include presentations from the senior management of Cammell-Laird on the overall programme that is planned and will be followed by an opportunity for supplier's to engage in one-to-one discussions with procurement and technical managers from the shipyard. There will also be an opportunity for delegates to tour the shipyard in small groups.

PROGRAMME

The conference will be held on Tuesday 20 February 2018. Industry delegates are invited to register from 0930 at the Maritime & Engineering College North West, in Birkenhead, adjacent to the Cammell-Laird shipyard. The presentations will start at 1000 and will be followed by a light networking buffet lunch providing an opportunity for informal discussions with shipyard officials.

This will be followed in the afternoon by a structured programme of private face-to-face dialogue with procurement and technical managers and tours of the shipyard in small groups for those interested.

Industry representatives, especially from SMEs, who are involved in the many aspects of shipbuilding supply chains, procurement, marketing products and services, are strongly urged to attend.
