INTRODUCTION

EURONAVAL 2022, the biennial International Naval Defence & Maritime Exhibition and Conference, will take place from 18 to 21 October 2022 at the Le Bourget Exhibition and Conference centre in Paris. Supported by the French Ministry of Defence and the French Navy, it is the major naval and maritime defence exhibition in Europe in the alternate years to the DSEI exhibition in the UK.

The Society of Maritime Industries is organising and managing the UK Group of exhibitors in an area of the hall dedicated exclusively to UK companies. The UK Pavilion attracts visitors and international delegations are expected.

The exhibition is open to exhibitors world-wide from companies or groups of companies which design, manufacture, maintain, repair or modernise naval equipment, including naval aviation equipment, refit ships, support fleets, train personnel, and promote, sell or provide naval and maritime security services, or produce documentation and journals connected with the naval and maritime security industry.

THE UK GROUP AT EURONAVAL 2022

UK companies are invited to take advantage of the UK Group package and buying either space only for their own self-build stands or by exhibiting on pre-constructed enhanced shell-scheme stands under the unique UK Pavilion livery. The advantages of joining the UK Group are:

- SMI has secured a prime location in the exhibition hall for the UK Group exhibitors on self-build stands and on enhanced shell-scheme stands from 9 sqm in the UK Pavilion.
 This means higher footfall to your stand than you would booking individually.
- The UK Pavilion includes an information centre and refreshments for the exclusive use of exhibitors in the UK Group.
- Social media (LinkedIn/Twitter) promotion of the pavilion
- Branding to highlight the UK Pavilion
- A programme, managed by the UK Group staff, ensures that visiting delegations are routinely brought to all UK Group exhibitors.
- Interaction with the DIT DSE team to maximise introductions and contacts at the event.



Stand Build Options

The exhibition organisers require exhibitors to contract directly with them for either bare space or shell scheme stands as appropriate.

Shell Scheme Standbuild

Please see below examples of the standbuild. Production and mounting of graphics locally is available for an extra fee. Further items like TV monitors, counters, cupboards are also available from the exhibitor manual.

FOR EXHIBITORS JOINING THE UK GROUP

The organiser's regulations require ALL companies to contract directly with them as DIRECT EXHIBITORS. The contract includes the exhibition participation fee and the cost of either bare space for self-build stands or the basic shell scheme stands. Payment in Euros including the 30% deposit must be made directly to the French organisers in accordance with the payment schedule on their registration form. VAT is NOT payable.

Exhibitors on UK Pavilion shell-scheme stands benefit from an enhanced shell-scheme design. All additional costs are included in the relevant UK package fees payable separately to SMI. You will receive an invoice in £ Sterling from the Society for the appropriate package fee including VAT.

SMI Terms & Conditions

- 1. All stands must be in the name of a UK registered company.
- SMI may acknowledge receipt of an application to participate in the exhibition.
 Such acknowledgement does not commit SMI to allocate the stand space in any specific location in the exhibition hall.
- UK Group packages fees for exhibitors on shell scheme stands in the UK Pavilion include provision of an enhanced design to the basic shell-scheme stand contracted for with the French organisers and SMI's administrative charges.
- Exhibitors must pay in full all invoices for package fees on registering. Failure to do so may be regarded as a breach of this contract.
- No additional construction to the shellscheme is permitted, except by prior and written agreement from SMI.
- Companies having received such agreement from SMI are themselves responsible for seeking quotes, commissioning and payment of additional construction to the shell-scheme.
- SMI will make every effort to ensure the size
 of stand requested is provided by the
 French organisers but cannot guarantee in
 advance either the hall, position,
 configuration of stand, or total area that can
 be provided.
- Where it is necessary to offer an area varying by greater than 20% of the area requested, SMI will first seek the agreement of the applicant.
- If compromise cannot be reached, an exhibitor party to this agreement remains responsible for payment of the whole stand available.
- 10. Should it be necessary to allocate a stand area in the UK Pavilion greater than originally requested, the exhibitor must pay in full on receipt of invoice for additional

- areas. Should it be necessary to allocate a stand area less than originally requested, SMI will arrange for a refund to the exhibitor from the French organisers of the difference in stand fees.
- 11. Every reasonable care will be taken in the allocation of space to exhibitors in the UK Pavilion to avoid inclusion of pillars and fire hydrant access points on stands. Where this is not possible, SMI will ensure companies will not be charged for net stand area displaced by pillars, or hydrants.
- 12. SMI is unable to guarantee that it is able to offer sufficient space to satisfy the total UK Group requirement. Space will therefore be allocated strictly in order of receipt of applications supported by payment.
- Exhibitors withdrawing from the UK Group after registration will forfeit their package fees in full unless a replacement company can be found.
- 14. Where a replacement exhibitor can be found, a charge of 20% of package fees will be charged to the withdrawing exhibitor to cover the additional administrative costs incurred.
- 15. SMI shall not be held liable for ensuring that the exhibitor, its personnel, and exhibits are adequately insured against all risks.
- 16. In submitting this application, exhibitors accept responsibility for ensuring that they are adequately insured against all accident, claims arising from negligence and that their exhibits are also insured against loss, or damage.
- 17. No damage may be caused to the shell-scheme, or display aids supplied, particularly by use of nails, or tacks for attaching panels to the shell-scheme walls.
- 18. If damage is so caused, companies will be liable to meet the full cost of replacement of the damaged items.



- Exhibitors are forbidden to further embellish the fascia panels of their stands by use of unauthorised additional graphics, or display aids.
- 20. Exhibitors are not to promote their presence and exhibits in a manner likely to cause offence, or nuisance to other exhibitors, or in contravention of the organisers' terms and conditions of participation.
- 21. From time to time, SMI may appoint service companies to offer group freight, travel, accommodation, promotion and other services as may be thought in the interests of the exhibitors.
- 22. Where SMI makes such appointments, exhibitors are free to make use of the

- services of such companies at their own risk.
- 23. SMI acts solely as an agent on behalf of the exhibitor and takes no liability for exhibitor's recovery of monies paid to the French organisers who before the completion of the delivery and the build of the stands becomes bankrupt or otherwise ceases to trade.
- 24. SMI shall not be held liable for the performance, actions or negligence of appointed contractors by the organisers.
- 25. In submitting this application, the exhibitor agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions and those of the French organisers.
