What's MAChallenge all about?

Encourage future talent that is the life-blood of the UK's MAS industry.

The challenge:

- To get undergraduate students thinking about role of MAS in addressing societal challenges
- Stretch students' knowledge and promote creative thinking
- Encourage team working through a variety of individual skills
- Connect the brightest young talent coming through the UK's universities with the UK's MAS Industry

How?

- Autonomous control of a USV to solve a range of given tasks

Competition Scope

- Teams of up to **five**; **four** of whom **must** be full time undergraduate students registered at a recognised UK university.
- Three phases:
 - Phase I – Video submission
 - Phase II – Project coaching
 - Phase III - On-water competition
- Teams will be down-selected after Phases I & II
- Cash prize to the winning team

Sensor payload

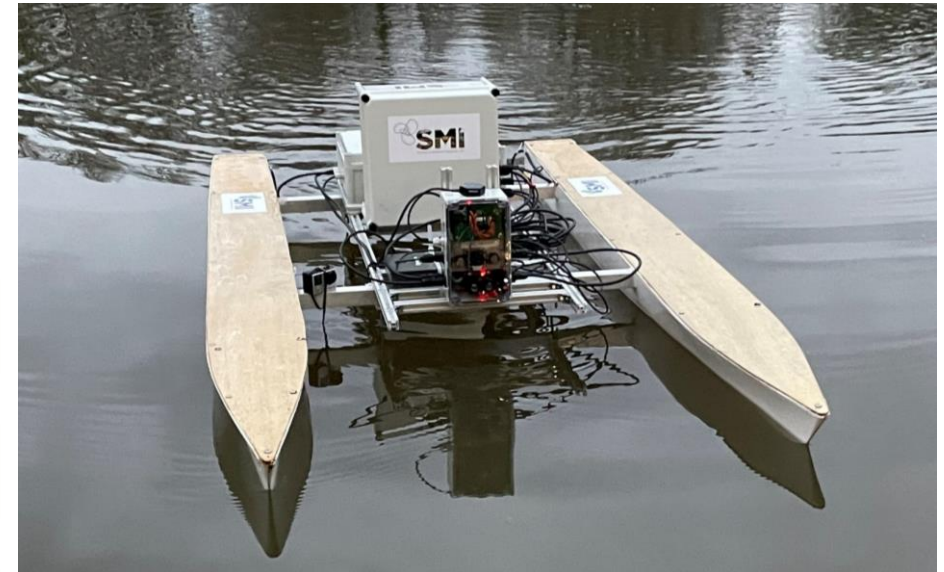

 - Show them you're interested in their talent


